■ MS Gill sanctions ₹50 lakh for construction of girls' hostel at SCD College

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As students of SCD Government College have been facing problems due to inadequate hostel accommodation for girls, an alumnus of the college has come to the aid of the college. Rajya Sabha member Manohar Singh Gill, who is an alumnus of the college, has sanctioned Rs 50 lakh for the college for the con-

struction of a girls hostel under the Member of Parliament Local Area Development (MPLAD) scheme.

Principal of the college Dharam Singh Sandhu

said the release of funds for constructing an extension to the girls hostel would benefit students coming from far-off places to pursue postgraduation at the college.

While releasing the funds for this purpose, Dr Gill has said girls' education is top priority and every citizen of the country must play his or her own part to ensure it.

Dr Gill has instructed

the Department of Panchyati Raj and Rural Development to complete the construction of the building of the girls' hostel within a time frame, so that the facility can be extended to the needy girls as early as possible.

Dr Sandhu said Dr Gill had been liberal to his alma mater. He had provided funds from the MPLAD scheme earlier too.
